Members of the department in the subject concerned where the candidate conducted research and outside specialists, if any, may participate in the public viva-voce examination. The supervisor shall convey to the University the result of such public viva voce examination duly endorsed by the external examiner. A candidate who is also successful at the public viva voce examination shall be declared to have qualified for the Ph.D. degree by the Vice Chancellor.
